


## Little Wandle Phonics Autumn 2

We will be continuing with phase 5 in phonics this half term. Phase 5 is when we learn alternate graphemes (ways of writing) for phonemes (sounds) that we already know from phase 2 and 3. For example, in phase 3 the children learnt /ee/ sheep in the jeep.  In phase 5 we will learn that ea (eat), e (he), e-e (these), ie (shield), y (happy) and ey (key) are all different ways of writing this same sound. As we learn all of these different ways we explain to the children that we are growing the code-our code for writing. We use our grow the code chart in class to help us write these graphemes. Here are the graphemes we will be learning this half term. Please see the attached information to support your child at home. More information can be found on our website.
