### What is a map?

A map is a drawing of all or part of Earth's surface. Its basic purpose is to show where things are. Maps may show things we can see, such as rivers and lakes, forests, buildings, and roads. They may also show things that cannot be seen, such as boundaries and temperatures.

## <u>Symbols</u>

Maps use symbols to show the different things found in an area. Some maps have a key to explain the symbols.

## Compass

A compass can be used to help you find your way. It shows four directions - north, east, south and west. It is useful to people who are, for example, navigating ships and aircraft, explorers, builders, etc.



village: A village is a small place where people live and work. They are often surrounded by the countryside.



town: A town is a place where people live and work. There may be shops, places of worship, leisure facilities and schools there. It is bigger than a village but smaller than a city.



city: A city is larger than a town. They are often very busy. There is normally lots to see and do.
