English

Writing: Narrative and Instructions.

SP&G: We are working on using capital letters, fingers spaces and full stops consistently and independently.

Handwriting: Physical strengthening of the body, correct pencil grip and correct letter formation.

Maths

Place value to 100 - Counting to 100, partitioning.

Multiplication and division - Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's

Fractions – finding half and a quarter of a shape/quantity

Position and direction – turns, left and right, positions
