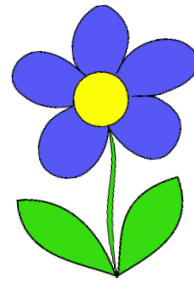
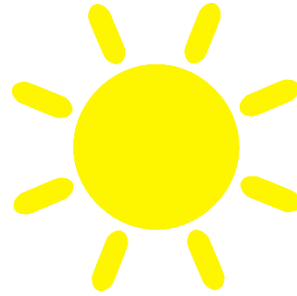


Maths: Positional Language

Summer Picture Instructions

1. Draw a sun in the middle of your page.
2. Draw a cloud above the sun.
3. Draw a flower below the sun.
4. Draw a butterfly to the left of the flower.
5. Draw a bee to the right of the flower.
6. Draw a tree on the left side of the page.
7. Draw a tree on the right side of the page.
8. Draw a bird between the cloud and the sun.
9. Draw some grass under the flower.
10. Draw a ball next to the flower.



Challenge Questions

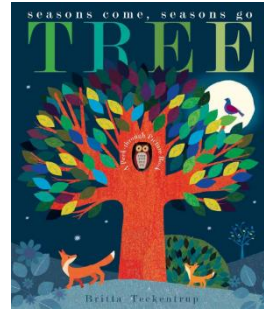
After drawing:

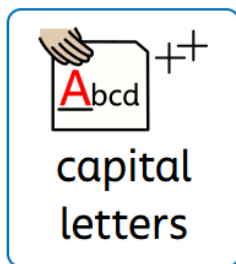

Reading activity:

Reading Word Hunt Challenge

Choose a book. This could be your Little Wandle Phonics book, one from your own collection or a story online.

Read your book and see how many of these you can find:

- ★ 3 words that begin with the same letter
- ★ 2 describing words (adjectives)
- ★ 1 word that is new to you
- ★ 1 word with more than 6 letters
- ★ 2 words that rhyme (or almost rhyme)
- ★ 1 word that makes you laugh or sounds funny
