Carbon Monoxide Awareness

Last week, pupils in Year 2 and Year 5 took part in Carbon Monoxide Awareness Workshops led by Bonanza Creative. Through interactive tasks and age-appropriate discussions, they learned what carbon monoxide is, why it can be dangerous, and how to stay safe. They explored real-life scenarios to recognise symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning and discovered why it is essential to have a working alarm at home. All children in these classes got an alarm to take home.


